The school runs extra-curricular sports club for pupils in year 1& 2 at lunchtimes during the year (football, multi-sports, dance fitness etc). All pupils take part in The Daily Mile each morning along with daily physical activities as part of the learning. PE is timetabled for all year groups each week.

The school is a Healthy School and only allows healthy snacks to be eaten at snack time. Fruit is available in each class should a child come

to school without a suitable snack. Water is available for pupils to drink throughout the school day.
