This year has been significant for our school. After an uncertain start, we were delighted to confirm that Trallwng Infants will remain open. Thank you for your incredible support throughout this period and for your involvement in school events such as assemblies, Sports Day, the mudder event, and the summer fete. Your contributions and the PTA's hard work have enriched pupils' experiences beyond the classroom.

Staffing Updates:

- Farewell to Mrs Francis after 10 years of dedicated service.
- Congratulations to Miss Sullivan (Acting Headteacher) and Miss Williams (Acting Deputy Headteacher).

School Performance:

- The New Curriculum for Wales is fully embedded, with strong pupil progress tracking.
- Attendance reached **92.2%**, below the 94% target. Governors are working with staff to improve this.

Finance:

Funding supported staffing, curriculum resources, wellbeing, digital tools, outdoor learning, and ALN provision. Spending is closely monitored for best value.

Key Achievements:

- **Curriculum & Independence:** School Senedd launched; pupils led campaigns and events.
- **Welsh Language:** Daily Helpwr Heddiw sessions embedded; staff trained for consistency.
- **Community Links:** Foodbank donations, Remembrance Day parade, museum partnership, dementia awareness projects.
- **Learning Environment:** New Early Years unit and sensory room installed.
- **Professional Development:** Staff trained in pedagogy, leadership, and inclusive practice.

Additional Learning Needs:

3 pupils received Individual Development Plans (IDPs). Provision aligns with the ALN Code for Wales.

Healthy Living:

Whole-school approach to healthy eating, free milk, and daily tooth brushing programme.
